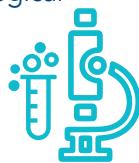


Systematic investigation to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge with the intent of peer-reviewed publication.

ADVANCES KNOWLEDGE

BIOMEDICAL SCIENCE RESEARCH

Examines the mechanisms underlying development and normal function of humans and other living organisms to gain insights into pathological and pathophysiological mechanisms causing disease



CLINICAL RESEARCH

Studies involving human subjects with findings applied to medical practice for prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of medical conditions (can include epidemiology, clinical trials)



TRANSLATIONAL RESEARCH

1) Discovery research in laboratory and preclinical studies applied to the development of human trials and studies
2) Studies of efficacy and cost-effectiveness of prevention and treatment strategies to accelerate adoption of best practices in communities and populations



SOCIAL SCIENCE RESEARCH

Studies involving Psychology (human behaviors), sociology (social groups), economics (firms, markets, economies)



EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH

Examines human attributes, interactions, organizations, and institutions that shape educational outcomes
