This new minor allows non-music majors who have an interest in continuing their musical pursuits a way to do so. Currently, non-majors are able to audition for music ensembles, often as zero credit courses. This minor allows them a vehicle to do so for credit, and with access to music courses and facilities otherwise reserved only for majors. This minor will generate new SCH for the Department of Music, as courses and seats are already available. By requiring one of Music's two ^{GE} courses, this minor may be added to a degree program with minimal additional credits, nine. In consultation with University Advising, we believe there is significant demand for this minor.

Undergraduate Minor

Minimum of 12 credits required

The Undergraduate Minor in Music allows non-music majors to continue their musical pursuits while majoring in another degree program. Students may earn this minor by completing twelve (12) credit hours: one General Education course in music (3 credits), a required zero (0) credit music course, three (3) required credits in music, and six (6) additional music elective credits. 9 of the 12 credits must be at the upper level. At least 75% of this minor must be completed at FAU. Students completing the minor must have a minimum overall FAU grade point average of 2.0 within the coursework required.
